The **Studio Furniture 2010 Wood Conference** will mark the opening of the landmark Studio Furniture 2010 Exhibition at Bungendore Wood Works Gallery, NSW. Seventy works will feature in an exhibition which will run until April 21. The winners of three cash awards totalling \$10,000 will be announced and presented at the exhibition opening which takes place at 6pm, Saturday Jan 23. Conference participants will be invited to attend. The \$150 fee to attend the conference includes participation, light lunch and morning and afternoon tea on Saturday, Jan 23, as well as participation in the exhibition floortalk on Jan 24.

The conference will take place at the Carrington Inn at 21 Malbon St, Bungendore, directly opposite Bungendore Wood Works Gallery. Proceeds from conference go towards funding return transport of unsold SF2010 works. Entries from all states have been selected for this unique national exhibition.
